

While in Coober Pedy he made friends who were special to him, friends who turned out to be cousins.

He would often go down to the farm in Mambray Creek to spend time with his aunty Debby, uncle Jimmy and baby brother Jayden, he enjoyed going with uncle Jimmy to help with farm duties such as feeding the animals, where ever uncle Jimmy went Darryl would follow.

Nana Elsie could remember him giving poppa Rodney a hard time at the farm in Baroota often shaping up to him and that's how he got his name Tiny Mil Logan knowing he would get lollies and other treats off his pop and nana after being mischievous.

Darryl would often go to see Sharon his mother, on his bike and ask for money. To buy himself something to eat. He was and will always be his mums tiny.

Cassie recalls Darryl singing out to her when he sees her at woolies Yakka and she would tell him don't say yakka too many Udnus around but he would say it anyway just to stir her up.

While driving up to Iga Warta a few weeks ago Cassie told him to be quiet but he would keep annoying her by singing the Akon song I'm a troublemaker.


Brother and sister use to get on during discussions but it always ended with an argument and tears.

While traveling to the meeting Darryl noticed Lulu's hair and walked into the shop at Leigh Creek and came out full of smiles and said to Lulu I've got something for you, he pulled out of his pocket a small bottle of shampoo and conditioner, which Lulu still has.

Darryl would often try to follow Ethan everywhere he went but Ethan would tell him don't follow me go your own way he would say nah I'm not following I'm going with these other boys not you.

While his ooly Roy was at a meeting in Leigh Creek Darryl, Ethan and Tyron spent the day with Aunty Glenda, Nana Elsie and Rodney at Aroona Dam he enjoyed that day because he enjoyed being out bush and running amuck with his cousin and two brothers.

He was a free spirited child who did what he wanted when he wanted to but always went back to ooly Roy's because he was his oolys right hand loving little man.



Many fights developed between him and his brother Tyron over the front seat. He would tell Tyron go back to your Ooly Rossy, this is my Oolys car.

Every time Aunty Justine would get in the car with Darryl and Tyron she would tell them this car ain't moving until I hear the click of the seatbelts. Tyron picked up on the message from his Aunty and one day said the same thing to Darryl. Darryl promptly replied who the hell do you think you are?

Darryl would sometimes stay at Roger Street if ooly couldn't pick him up with Samantha (manda) and John and he loved to play with his nephew AJ and Niece Layla

Darryl will be sadly missed but remembered fondly by Aunty Michelle and Uncle Gavin as he was one of the boys who would stay over often with Gavin and Garron as he insisted on being a part of the gang.

He spent most of his time in Port Augusta attending Carlton Primary school, school wasn't really something he enjoyed especially the getting up early in the morning he often got into a few scuffles with the other kids and ooly Roy would be at the school nearly every day.

Darryl was a frequent visitor of Abdul and Kerry's, he often said his favourite uncle was Abdul because he gave him \$10 so one day his uncle Roy gave him \$20 and asked now who is your favourite uncle? He said uncle Abdul because he gave me \$10. He was only about 4 or 5 at the time.

We all have a few stories and fond memories of a special loving little man. A keen footballer playing for Centrals and South Augusta but an avid Power supporter.

We say goodbye with pain in our hearts and tears that can't erase the pain, but we know that you are now safe with your Nanas, Poppas, Oolys, Uncles, Aunts and Cousins

Darryl will be sadly missed but forever remembered by his Father Jack, Mother Sharon, Stepmother Lulu, Stepfather Clifford, Sister Cassandra, Brothers Ethan, Tyron and Jayden. In death we do the same.


It broke our hearts to lose you,
