

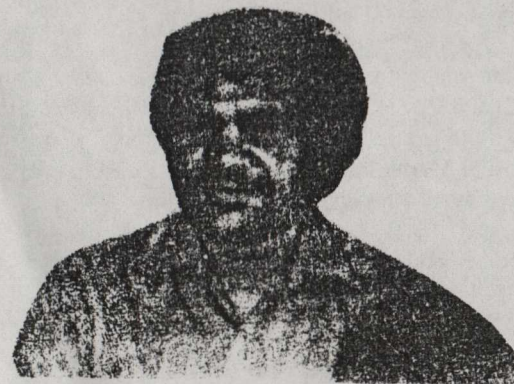

His up-bringing was one that seen him exposed to the Gospel.. Quite often Ian would attend the little fellowship in Copley, and other various places.

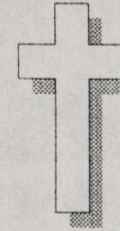
