Hilda Fejo nee Murray was born on the 12th November 1940 at Mumpeowie Station. She is the eldest daughter of Jack Murray and Olga Hannes.

When she was a small child she grew up living with her family in the sandhills around Davenport Community. Then she was placed into the Umeewarra Children's Home because her family wanted her to get a good education.

On leaving Umeewarra Hilda and some of the other girls Jessie Mungaranie, Dorothy Lennon, Marlene Reid, Clarice Ivy, & later on Judy Martin moved to Sydney for work. She stayed with the Morsillo family and began nursing at Shalom in Sydney. Then she went to Singleton Bible College in New South Wales. There she met Wally Fejo for the first time.

Sadly her sister was taken tragically from them and her sister's children Kevin (dec), Alfie (dec) and Dorothy, went to live with her mother. But then her mother became ill and the children were placed at the Mission and Hilda came home and took full responsibility for these children.

She was a strong, private woman and she never went on any sort of welfare she always managed just on the child endowment.

Hilda was a very kind woman and family was very important to her. She looked after many of the children in her family throughout her life including Uncleboy, Peter O'Toole, Deanoboy, Scotty Sn, Natalie and Gabrielle (dec).

During the 1970's she was a teacher's aid at Willsden Primary School and was much loved by the students at the school.

She lived at Stirling North and her step father Raymond Boland Sn and family used to come and stay. Her door was always to family and her Uncle Albert would come down from the stations to stay with her.

She loved her animals and Dotty remembers when she was nasty to one of her cats and she got a hiding from her Aunty, but then she sent her to the shop with \$5 so she really was a softy.
