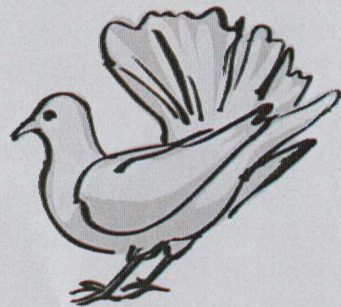


Robert will always be remembered for his kind hearted ways, his sense of humour and love of a joke. He will be sadly missed and forever remembered by his family, friends and all who knew him.

Robert was born on July 17th 1952 at the Broken
Hill Hospital, the youngest son of Doreen and
Laurie Stuart.

He grew up with his mum, dad and family at Finnis
Springs and attended school until Grade Seven at the
Marree School.

He later went to work with his eldest brother Lenny
and eldest nephew Phillip with the Australian
National Railways for a few years at the Neuroodla
Railway Siding.

After attending Shunter's School down at Port
Augusta for six weeks he worked as a Shunter at
Marree and Alice Springs.

Then in 1972 / 73 he went to the Northern Territory
where he worked on Kilarny Stn as a Ringer.

Robert was well liked by station owner Bill Tapp
and family and were sad to see him return home.

Later writing him a letter asking about him and
wishing him well.

In his later years his Kidneys began to fail him so he
had to have Dialysis treatment on a regular basis.

Sadly Robert was diagnosed with cancer and as his
health deteriorated he was unable to fully care for
himself. He then returned to Port Augusta to be

cared for by his sister Pauline in the home their
Father had also spent his last years. After a short
stay in the Port Augusta Hospital he was transferred
to the Royal Adelaide Hospital on the 20-12-05.

Robert passed away peacefully at 3.30am on
Christmas morning with his sister Joy holding his
hand and his sister Pauline and daughter Gail by his
bedside.
