for the RFDs

Also helped build the Mosque at Marree. Graham  
also worked at the Marree Hotel and liaised with the  
Marree Police Station. Graham was an outstanding  
mechanic and very clever at repairing anything  
electrical.

Graham loved sports and was a keen supporter of

Now reunited with his mother.



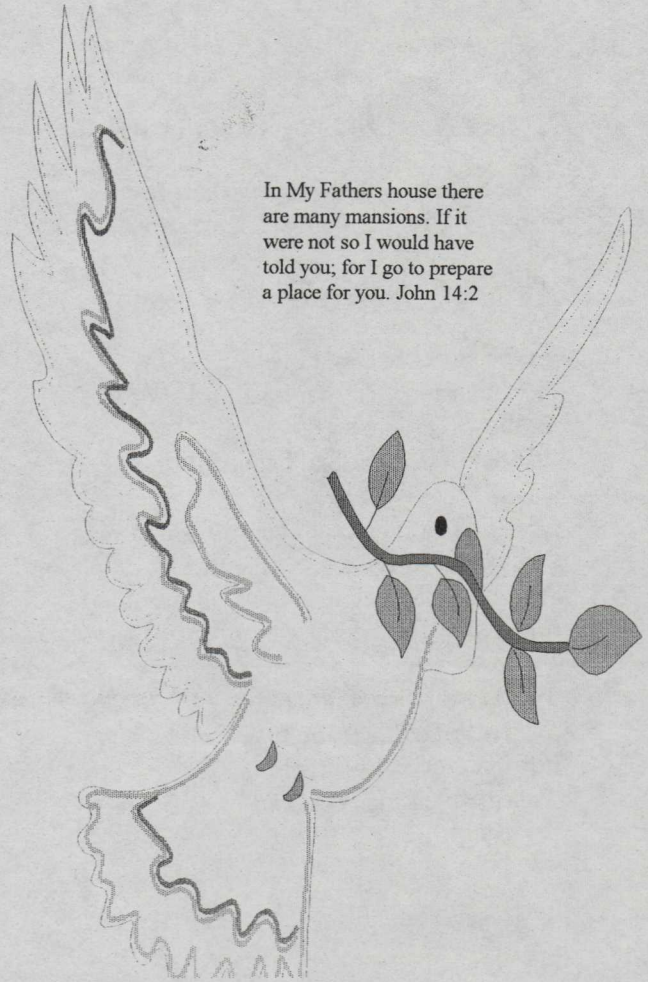
