## Eulogy

Justin was born at the Port Augusta Hospital on the 3<sup>rd</sup> October 1972 and due to illness his mother was very protective of him. After Justin's birth his parents resided at Finnis Springs Station with him, but then in 1978 the family moved to Marree due to his father's work commitments.

Justin and his family remained in Marree until 1980 and then they moved down to Stirling North in Port Augusta. During this time Justin was diagnosed with epilepsy, but he was determined not to let this illness interfere with the things he loved to do. He joined in many different sporting activities with his family and friends and was able to live quite a fruitful life as a child.

Justin had a great talent for sketching and some hobbies he enjoyed were building things out of wood, football and cricket for which he received trophies. His father would also take Justin and the family out hunting. Justin attended Willsden Primary School for a few years and then transferred to Central Primary Special School. During Justin's schooling he had many friends and was able to fit in quite well with everyone who knew him.

In 1986 Justin's mother passed away and his older sister Jodie cared for him from the age of 13 years old. He attended Port Augusta High School. At the age of 16 Justin met Sonya Gaston in 1990 their daughter Belinda was born and followed by his son Mathew.

Things didn't work out so Justin was travelled around by himself. He went to Alice Springs to live with his older sister Carol. He missed his two children deeply so he tried to see them as often as he could by travelling up and down between families.

In the year 1999 Justin met Valencia and formed a relationship, their son Stanley was born in 2002. He was a loving Stepfather to Valencia's two children Trevor and Delly. The family accepted Justin into their own and he was nicknamed (Just Jeans) because he always wore jeans even if it was hot. His in laws would say "put shorts on it's hot take your jeans off", and he would say with a grin I'm not showing my hairy white legs. Justin spent this Christmas at the block with his family in Alice Springs.

Sadly on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> December, 2005 Justin's lifelong struggle with Epilepsy caught up with him and he passed away at home with Family and Friends in Alice Springs.
